room-in-room constructions

when it comes to "soundproofing" there are many opinions, some of which are rooted in misunderstanding. to begin, by soundproofing we mean preventing sound transmission between rooms and not acoustic modification within a given room. the latter is equally important, but not what we are concerned with here. in terms of sound transmission there is one simple conclusion: the more walls, floors and ceilings you are able to decouple, the better.

ideally, one would build an entirely new room within a room. no other method would reach the same level of insulation. when you decide to build a "rir"-construction, there are a lot principles to be aware of, otherwise your construction would be doomed to failure. the smallest mistake would ruin the project and lot of money and work would be squandered.
